A Call for Volunteers

The Flint Regional Science and Engineering Fair (FRSEF) is reaching out for volunteers to help with the **2021 Fair**. Outreach efforts for the Senior Fair (grades 9-12) have been very successful, resulting in about twice the entries as previous years! This means **we need more help than ever**. But here's a twist: the 2021 FRSEF will be entirely virtual, so travel to Flint will not be necessary. **You can volunteer for wherever you have an Internet connection.**

We need **project judges** for the preliminary reviews to decide finalist and non-finalist categories and we need **interview judges** to interview the students. You may volunteer for one or both judging positions.

Online **preliminary judging will be from March 13th-17th**. Project judges will be asked to evaluate approximately 15 projects at their leisure during this time.

Judging **Interviews for the Senior division will take place Saturday morning, March 20, 2021**. Using Zoom breakout rooms, groups of judges will interview a series of students. With enough volunteers, the process should go quickly.

New this year, we also have a need for volunteers as **Zoom Meeting Monitors**, who will be responsible for the Fair's Zoom judging sessions, including strict start and stop times. These sessions will all be on Saturday, March 20th, starting at 8:30 am and running for about four hours. A comprehensive training session for Zoom Meeting Monitors will be held.

The Junior and Elementary Fairs will take place on April 11-15 (Preliminary Judging) and April 17 (Judging Interviews).

2021 has the potential to be one of our greatest Fairs, but much will depend on having dedicated volunteers to make it possible. I hope you will join us in being part of this one-of-a-kind STEM experience for our Mid-Michigan students.
